"I have heard that the new cassava variety matures in 8 months - I will be able to have two harvests in the time I used to have just one" says John Gambo. FARM-Africa helped John and his family to start growing a new type of fast maturing, disease resistant cassava.

could help establish a demonstration plot, providing an area where groups of farmers can test different seeds and techniques and find out which ones perform best and produce the biggest harvests.

£180

could help pay for the training and materials a farmer needs to build a shallow well on his land, providing precious water to grow vegetables and fruits such as kale, tomatoes and papaya.

£120

could help pay for a training session with an agricultural expert. Simple techniques such as intercropping can improve the quality of farmers' soil and the size of their harvest.

£60

could help provide two farmers with seeds that will thrive in harsh conditions, providing nutritious food for their families plus a surplus to sell at market.
