

KSI Art/DT Year 2

National Curriculum: DT KSI 1a, b, 2a, c, d.

Time: 60+ minutes

Cross Curricular Link: Science Sc3 1a, c, d.

Children will collect a variety of images and pictures, relevant to aspects of farming in Africa, to create a collage on the welly template.

Preparation

- 1 welly template per child
- 1 sheet of A4 coloured card per child
- Class set of scissors, glue and gluesticks.
- Magazines and newspapers collected by children or staff.

Whole Class Teaching

Tell the children that they are going to make a collage. What is a collage? It will be made up from lots of different pictures that they think have something do with farming in Africa. They are going to cut out the shape of a welly in card as a base for the collage.

Mind-map what kind of pictures they might be looking for – crops, animals, sun, water, tools, buckets, etc. Go through a magazine and discuss good and bad choices of pictures. (Highlight that it could also be a small part of a larger picture).

Demonstrate how to cut out the image they want and stick it to the welly. Remind children about safety when using scissors.

Independent Work

Each child selects an A4 sheet of card, draws round the welly template and then cuts it out. They then begin to find images and pictures from the magazines, etc, cut them out and stick them onto their wellies to make their collages.

Lower ability children could work in pairs or use pre-selected images for their collage.

Higher ability children could base their collage on a theme: crops, water, etc.

Plenary

Ask children to hold up their collage and to explain what pictures they have chosen and why. Use the wellies to make a classroom display.
